ELPS is seeking two individuals to fill "floating paraprofessional" positions. These individuals will be assigned to sub for unfilled paraprofessional absences across the district but primarily at the elementary level. Floating paras will be assigned a "home building" at which to report daily and may be assigned to go to another building to fill an unfilled job for that day. The position is 35 hours per week and includes full benefits per the ELESPE collective bargaining agreement.
