ELPS COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics for Children Ages 5 - 11

Last Tuesday, the Ingham County Health Department held a vaccination clinic at East Lansing High School for newly eligible children. The date for the second dose is Tuesday, November 30 - appointment times are the same as they were for this past Tuesday.

Our next clinic is scheduled for this Saturday, November 20 from 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. with second doses Saturday, December 11 at the same time. As of this morning, there were just a few appointments available.

If you previously made an appointment and have since found a different source for your child's vaccine, please go in and cancel your appointment so we can make that time slot available for others still seeking an appointment.

Both clinics will be held in the Student Union (cafeteria) at East Lansing High School. Please park in the lot behind the tennis courts and enter the building through Door #8 (Night Activities Entrance). Staff will be there to provide direction. adult will be allowed in the union for each child in order to allow as much distancing as possible.
