## **Universal Masking Still a Requirement in ELPS**

Friday, the Center for Disease Control (CDC) released new "COVID-19 Community Levels' that guide recommendations for COVID-19 mitigation strategies.

Prior to Friday, there were four categories: High, Substantial, Moderate and Low

Now, there are three categories: High, Medium and Low

COVID-19 Community Levels are a new tool to help communities decide what prevention steps to take based on the latest data. Levels can be low, medium, or high and are determined by looking at hospital beds being used, hospital admissions, and the total number of new COVID-19 cases in an area.

Ingham County is currently in the MEDIUM Community Level.

The CDC recommends the following guidelines for communities in the Medium level:

- If you are at high risk for severe illness, talk to your healthcare provider about whether you need to wear a mask and take other precautions
- Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines
- · Get tested if you have symptoms

At this point in time, masks are still required in East Lansing Public Schools buildings and on ELPS busses. This topic will be discussed at Monday night's Board of Education meeting.
